Mission and scope

This International Conference is the 9th in a series that began 26 years ago. This triennial event will be also the 1st Congress of the recently established International Society for Applied Phycology (ISAP). The Conference provides the largest and most comprehensive forum for exchanges on the latest advances in algal biotechnology. The participants in the 9th International Conference on Applied Algology/1st ISAP Congress will include engineers, manufacturers, contractors, scientists, researchers, students, economists, industry representatives, and policymakers. The conference will provide an unparalleled opportunity for everyone to become current on the opportunities that algal biotechnology offers in the fields of aquaculture, human nutrition and health, agriculture, and the production of recombinant proteins in algae.

Host city: Almería

Almería, a city of 170,000 people is situated in the south of Spain, on the Mediterranean coast. Almería is a centre of agriculture and tourism and is the capital city of the Province of Almería. Almería's sunbathed and quiet beaches are a particular attraction. The region has a beautiful and varied landscape. Almería complements all this with good wine and excellent cuisine of Andalucía. Just some 20 kilometers away from the main City of Almería, Roquetas de Mar is the largest holiday resort in the Province. Roquetas de Mar hosts several golf course, wind surfing, hand gliding, etc, behind which is an area of salt marshes visited by flamingos, ducks and other fowl. For those warm Spanish nights there are a large number of activities available to compliment these.
