Learning System and Methodology / Contingency Plan

As this is a blended learning course: the sessions will be 50 % online + 50% in the classroom. 4 sessions will be devoted to online work and 4 sessions will take place in the classroom.

Methodology:

- Master class (+ participation) - Search, research and use of information - Written/oral activities
- Training activities (in person)
- Illustrative videos (Films, tv series, podcasts)
 - Participatory forum, sharing and exchange of knowledge

Training activities (multimodal sessions)

E-learning 1: Contemporary art/artists

E-learning 2: Literature and Film: comparing the same story

E-Learning 3: Poetry and music: research work

E-learning 4: Research work on literature and the media.

CONTINGENCY PLAN: The sessions to be carried out in the classroom will become non-presential, using sessions of synchronous videoconferences. Online and formative activities (e-learnings) will not vary.

Teaching Innovation Activities

As a member of the innovation group "Cross-disciplinary applications for the study of identity in English-language literatures" (2020-2022 biennium), a research/dissemination project will be carried out on multicultural literature in English written during the 21st century: "Multicultural short stories in English".
